<Intro>

1. Please introduce yourself. (Name, Nationality, Age, Major, etc.)
2. Please explain why you are applying this program.

<Sample Questionnaires> -You can use questions below in your presentation.

1. If you have teaching experience, explain the details and what you have learned from your experience.
2. What is your strength as an ESL teacher?
3. What is your teaching style and teaching philosophy?
4. Are you familiar with lesson planning?
5. How would you motivate students to learn English?
6. What would you do to develop a relationship with students and school faculty members?
7. Do you understand the cultural differences between Korea and your country? What are your thoughts on encountering culture differences?

<Video Recording Tips>

1. Before filming your video

- Wear suitable attire
- Be professional but friendly while filming yourself
- Keep your background Clean, Simple
- Adjust your lighting
- Make 3~5 minutes long Video clip
- Try to memorize your script, not read it while recording the video
- Do not need to answer all of the questions above, you can add or delete your own questionnaires if needed
- Can have somebody to help you ask questions during interview
- Make your own creative video

2. After filming your video

- Editing/Filming skill is also one of your strengths that you can show
- Upload it on the YouTube or Vimeo and send us a link. (Do not send us the video file)
- Ask questions to your recruiter if you need feedback
